Project Engineering Oversight Applicable to Any Construction Projects

The grant recipient shall engage an architect or professional engineer licensed in the State of Indiana to design or oversee the design of the project in order that the project will comply with all federal, state, and local codes and industry standards. The architect or professional engineer shall periodically observe the execution of the project and require that the execution be in compliance with all federal, state, and local codes and industry standards for the particular project. The observation periods shall be determined by the architect or professional engineer but shall be at least in accordance with industry standards.

The architect or professional engineer shall review and approve all pay requests prior to submission for payment to the Harrison County Community Foundation. The grant recipient shall review and approve all pay requests from the architect or professional engineer prior to submission for payment to the Harrison County Community Foundation. It is highly recommended that grant applicants involve an architect or professional engineer prior to application to aid in the formation of the project budget and to include the necessary design and oversight fees in the project budget. Fees not specifically included in the grant request will not be paid without a grant amendment subject to the approval procedures of the Harrison County Community Foundation.
