The Chamber of Commerce Scholarship was initiated in May 1989 at the urging of Indiana Business Research Center, Kelly School of Business Executive Director Morton Marcus when he spoke at the Chamber of Commerce annual meeting. That year one \$1,000 scholarship was awarded to an Indiana University Southeast bound Harrison County senior.

The scholarship program continued each year through generous donations from the Chamber membership and in 2001, through a scholarship capital campaign, the Chamber of Commerce of Harrison County Education Fund was established at the Harrison County Community Foundation (HCCF). HCCF provided a dollar for dollar match to create this endowment.
