Comfort House Fund

Comfort House established an endowment fund at the Harrison County Community Foundation in 2008. The purpose of the Fund is to provide support for the operations and programs of Comfort House.

Comfort House was established in 2004 as a Child Advocacy Center and is an associate member of the National Children's Alliance. Comfort House is located in Corydon and Milltown and provides services to families affected by sexual abuse. Services include a multi-disciplinary team forensic interview approach as well as the provision of a victim advocate in order to ensure appropriate referrals to counseling, etc. Comfort House staff is available to present information to community organizations regarding the necessity of child advocacy centers and the success of the multi-disciplinary team approach. Comfort House personnel work as a team with law enforcement, child protection services, prosecutors and advocates. Services are primarily offered in Harrison and Crawford Counties, however no one is denied services because of geographical location.
